Dear Family and Friends:

As we write this, Kathryn is filling out applications for colleges for the fall of 2012. It is hard to believe that next year she and Ben will both be in college, and Jacob and Levi will be in high school.

Ben continues his studies in mechanical engineering technology at LeTourneau University, Kathryn is enjoying her senior year, Jacob is playing a lot of ultimate Frisbee, and Levi was just voted president of the student government. We are very proud of the four of them and their desire to be followers of Jesus.

Quite often, where the JESUS Film is shown, small follow-up groups are formed, and churches are planted. This Friday (Nov 4<sup>th</sup>) I will be participating in meetings in Dallas with other partner organizations to talk about how the JESUS Film can be involved in the planting of five million new churches by 2020. This is a very exciting and challenging goal which will only be realized by the cooperative effort of several key partners and the powerful work of the Holy Spirit.

From Nov 11-18 I will be headed to Turkey for a strategic conference related to the Middle East. One of the strategies we will be discussing is a new media tool called "*Rivka*." In 2006, *Magdalena* was introduced, bringing the message of salvation, hope and dignity to the oppressed women of Central Asia and the Middle East. The response to *Magdalena* has been incredibly positive. As a result, the 12-episode series *Rivka* was created specifically to disciple new Christian women living with the difficult cultural challenges of this region. We are excited about what God is going to do through this new evangelism and follow-up media tool.

The JESUS Film Project continues to be committed to reaching the last, the least and the lost. On December 8-9, I will be attending a meeting in CA with a number of partner organizations focused on "Finishing the Task" of reaching these remaining unreached people groups. Our desire is to produce a JESUS Film for each of these estimated 865 targeted people groups.

Karen continues to expand her various roles in the Human Resources department. Just recently she completed a week of training for coaching new and existing staff who are working on developing financial support with financial ministry partners.
